Baby Bunny Softie

It doesn't get better than a soft, snugly, handmade toy.

Supplies:

Three color Baby Bunny Kit OR

1/8 yard or Fat Eighth of Organic Cotton Fleece

Cotton Stuffing

Wool Batting Scrap

Embroidery thread for face



Be sure to make a **Carrot Zipper Pouch** to keep your bunnies organized!

Step 1.

Fold the fabric in half, right sides together and trace the bunny pattern shape onto the wrong side of the top layer. **Do not cut on this line**, instead **sew** on the line you just drew, leaving a small section on the side of the bunny open to turn it right side out.

Step 2.

Cut the bunny out, leaving at least a 1/4" seam allowance around the outside. Clip the curves and cut a "v" into the corners where the bunny's head meets the ears.

Step 3.

Turn the bunny right side out and stuff. A chopstick works well to turn and stuff the small ears. Hand stitch the opening on the side of the bunny closed.

Step 4.

Hand stitch the face details as seen in the photo. We used french knots for the eyes, satin stitch for the nose and a simple running stitch for the mouth.



Step 5.

Hand stitch a scrap of wool batting to the back of the bunny for a tail.

Repeat! These bunnies are so cute and easy that we are sure they will multiply like, well... bunnies!

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
